

Other ways to say "this shows"



1. Demonstrates

Example: *The test result clearly **demonstrates** the student's hard work.*

2. Illustrates

Example: *He **illustrates** the lesson with a picture.*

3. Proves

Example: *The exception which **proves** the rule.*

4. Displays

Example: *She **displays** no indication of homesickness.*



5. Reveals

Example: *Tom **reveals** the secret of his success.*



6. Describes

Example: *Emma **describes** the poem beautifully.*

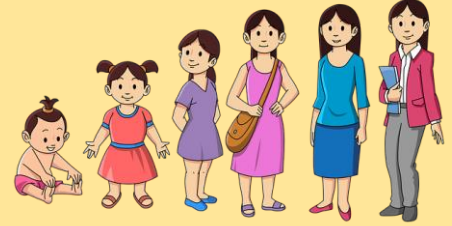
7. Highlights

Example: *Use blonde **highlights** to brighten your hair.*

Other ways to say "this shows"

8. Defines

Example: *Our attitude **defines** life.*



9. Illuminates

Example: *The sun **illuminates** the sky.*

10. Clarifies

Example: *I hope this **clarifies** my position.*

11. Exemplifies

Example: *This painting **exemplifies** the artist's early style.*



12. Portrays

Example: *It **portrays** him as kind and caring.*



13. Emphasises

Example: *It also **emphasises** that the worker wants to get it clear.*

14. Encapsulates

Example: *This story **encapsulates** scenes from his childhood.*

Other ways to say "this shows"



15. Connotes

Example: *To me, ice cream **connotes** pleasure and joy.*

16. Depicts

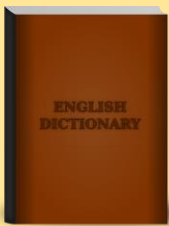
Example: *The drawing **depicts** her sitting on a sofa.*

17. Suggests

Example: *She **suggests** he go to France instead of Italy.*

18. Points out

Example: *This guide book **points out** the main facts of early American history..*



19. Explains

Example: *A dictionary **explains** the meaning of words.*

20. Confirms

Example: *This just **confirms** my worst fears.*

21. Indicates

Example: *Research **indicates** that eating habits are changing fast.*

Other ways to say "this shows"

22. Outlines

Example: *The **outlines** of animals were cut into the rock.*



23. Exhibits

Example: *He frequently **exhibits** at the art gallery.*

24. Establishes

Example: *The new treaty **establishes** a free trade zone.*

25. Presents

Example: *The report **presents** a caricature of the true situation.*



26. Points to

Example: *The building **points** to the east.*



27. Validates

Example: *This **validates** the germ theory of disease.*

28. conveys

Example: *This train **conveys** passengers to London.*
