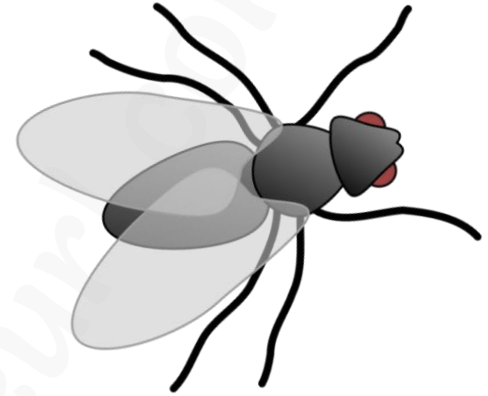


Housefly
