4. Could you give your opinions on academic success?



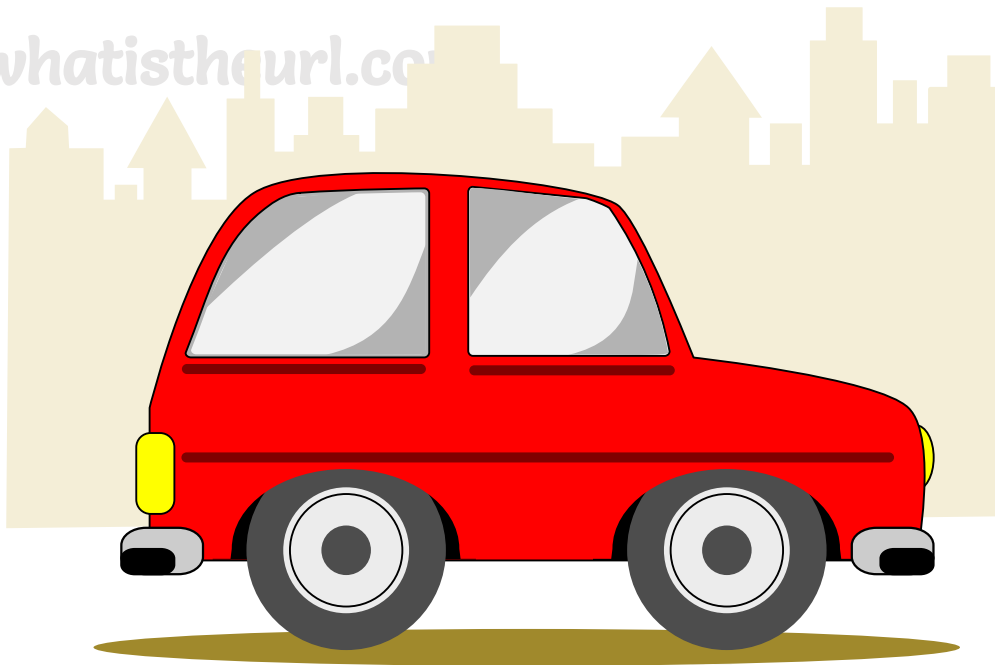
