

Reading comprehension for Grade 3 or 4

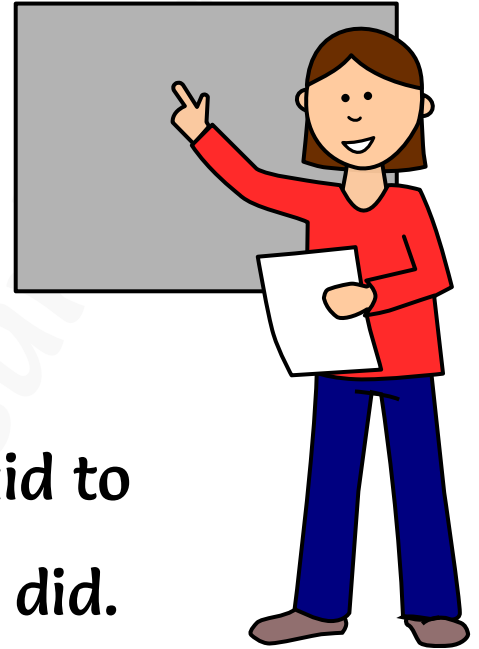
Don't Put All Your Eggs in One Basket.

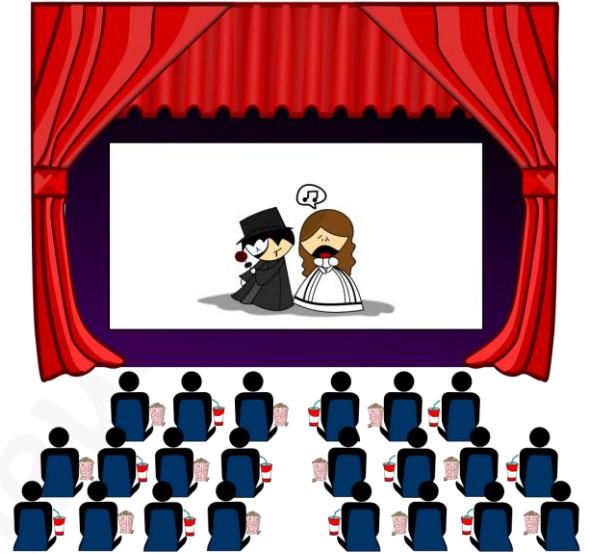
1. What did the boy do?

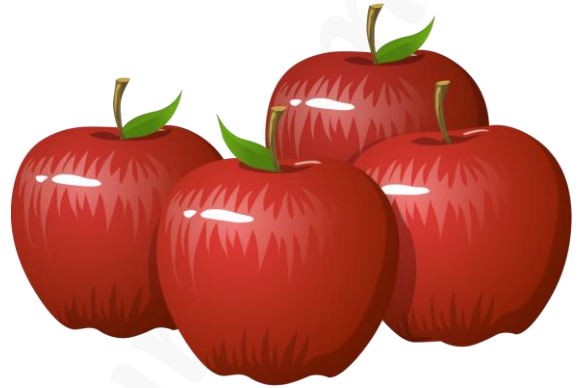
1. What was James preparing for?
