Don't Put All Your Eggs in One Basket.

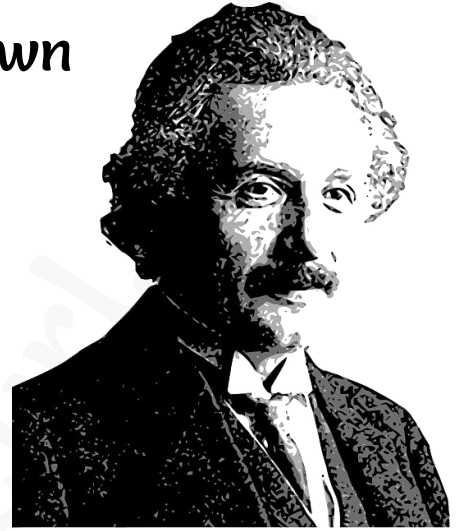
A bee is a type of insect that is typically yellow and black with the appearance of a “dressed-up bumblebee” with white and brown stripes.



Bees feed on flowers and pollen, and they also produce honey which is made up of water and sugar.

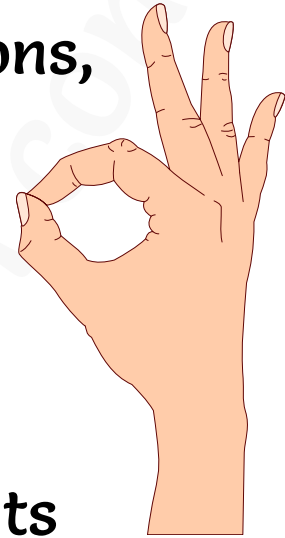
1. Give the above paragraph a title.

4. Name the theories mentioned above.

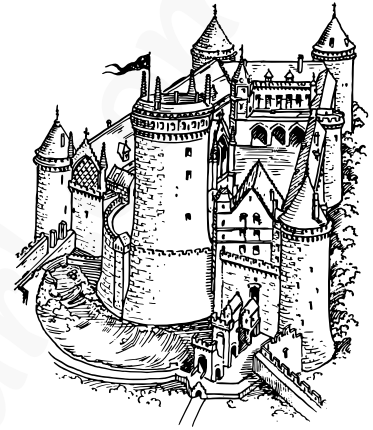
