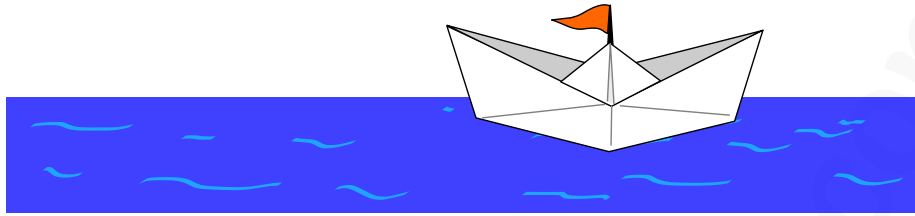
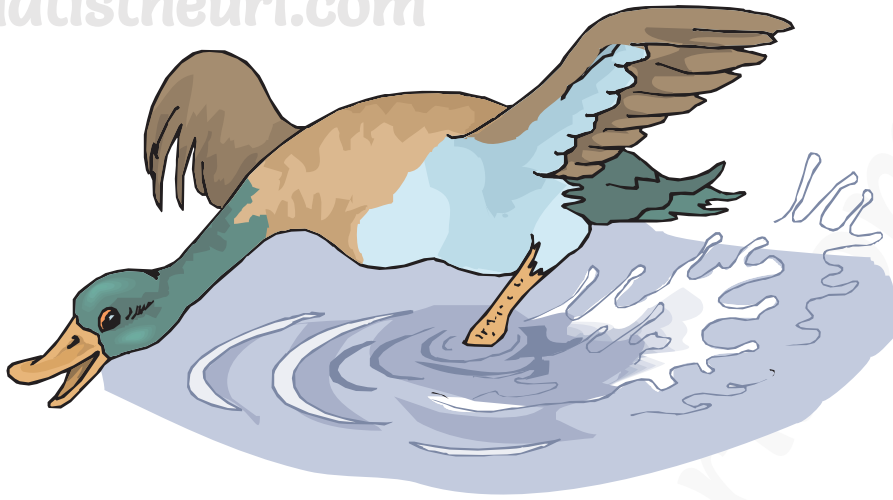


Reading comprehension for kids
