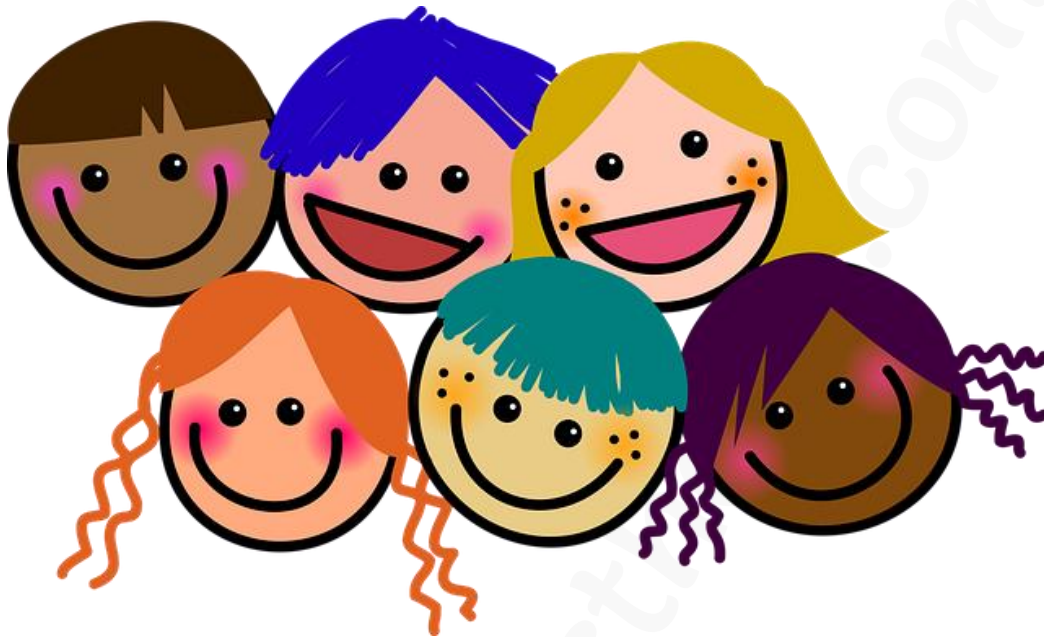


5 Reasons Why I Like My School
