walks in the forest or lay in the fields and watch

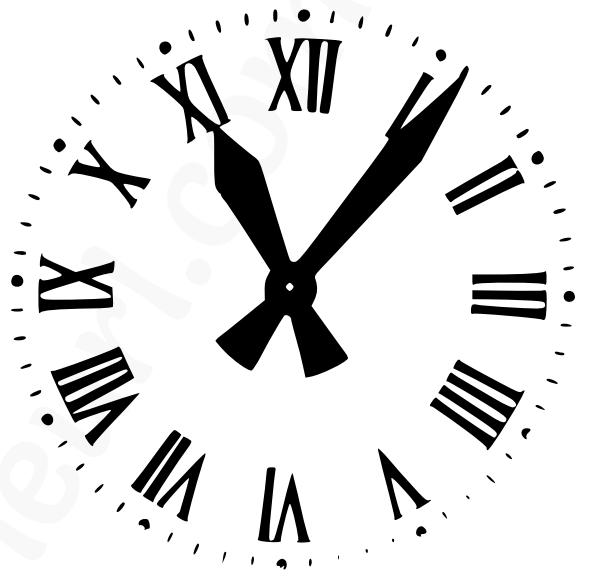
the clouds pass by.
