## Answer Key

### Answer Key for Context Clues Worksheet

- Persistent:** Continuing firmly despite obstacles; determined.
  - Clues:** "never gave up on her dream," "Despite many obstacles" suggests someone who does not quit easily and continues to pursue their goal.
- Spacious:** Having a lot of room; roomy.
  - Clues:** "large rooms," "tall ceilings," "made it feel even bigger" indicates a place with a lot of open space.
- Diminish:** To make or become smaller, weaker, or less important.
  - Clues:** "constant rain," "began to diminish the excitement," "making people leave early" suggests that something is decreasing or becoming less.
- Obtain:** To get something, usually through effort.
  - Clues:** "had to travel across the country," "visit several bookstores" shows that the person worked or travelled to get the rare book.
- Vigorous:** Strong, healthy, or full of energy.
  - Clues:** "took a vigorous approach to training," "exercising for hours every day" indicates high energy and intensity in the activity.
- Eccentric:** Unconventional and slightly strange; unusual in behavior or appearance.
  - Clues:** "wearing mismatched socks," "talking to plants," "made him stand out" suggests behavior that is unusual or different from what is considered normal.
- Defend:** To protect something from attack or harm.
  - Clues:** "asked to defend the castle," "against the invaders" shows that defending means protecting or fighting to keep something safe from others.
- Adapt:** To adjust or change in response to new conditions or environments.
  - Clues:** "survive in the harsh desert," "storing water in their thick stems" indicates the process of changing to fit the environment.
- Emerge:** To come out into view or become visible after being hidden or obscured.
  - Clues:** "storm passed," "sun began to emerge from behind the clouds" indicates that something is becoming visible after being hidden.
- Reconcile:** To restore friendly relations after a disagreement or conflict.
  - Clues:** "long argument," "make up," "realizing they both wanted the same thing" suggests that the two friends resolved their differences and became friendly again.
