The Magic Garden

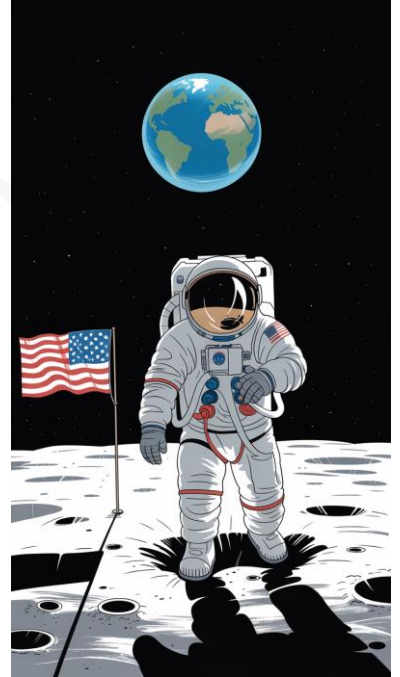

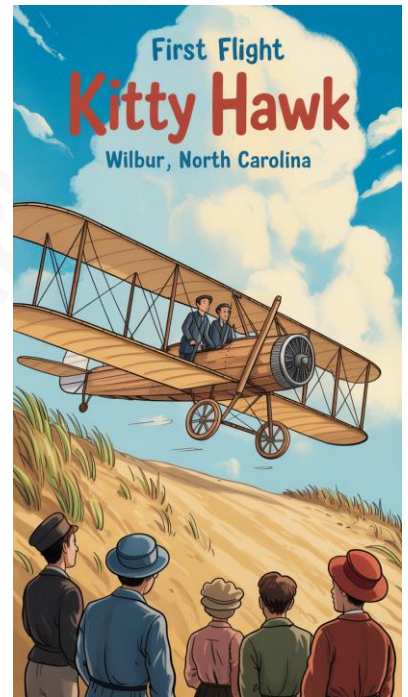
