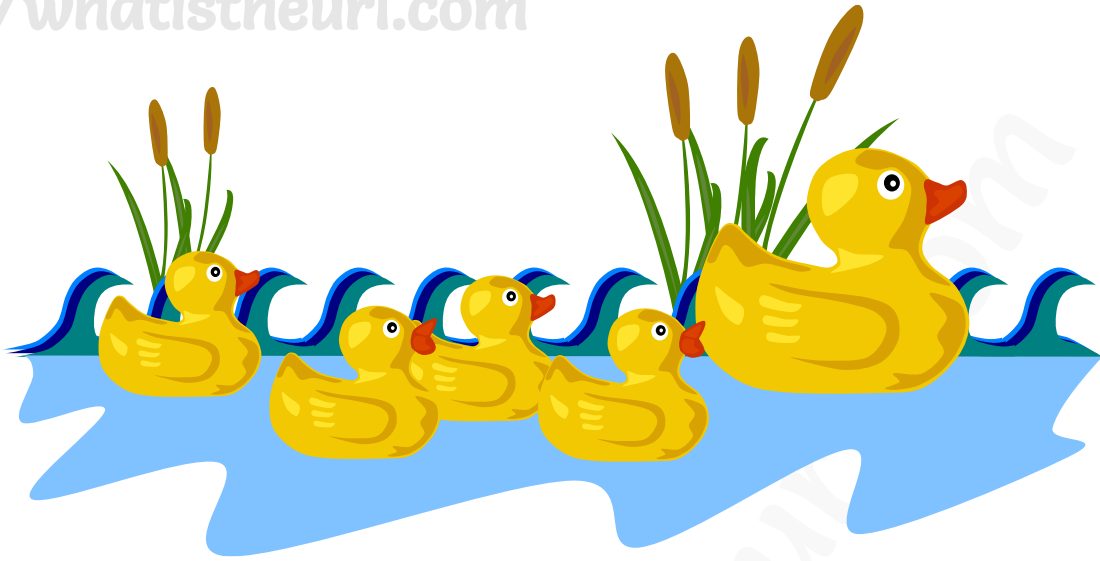


Reading comprehension for kids

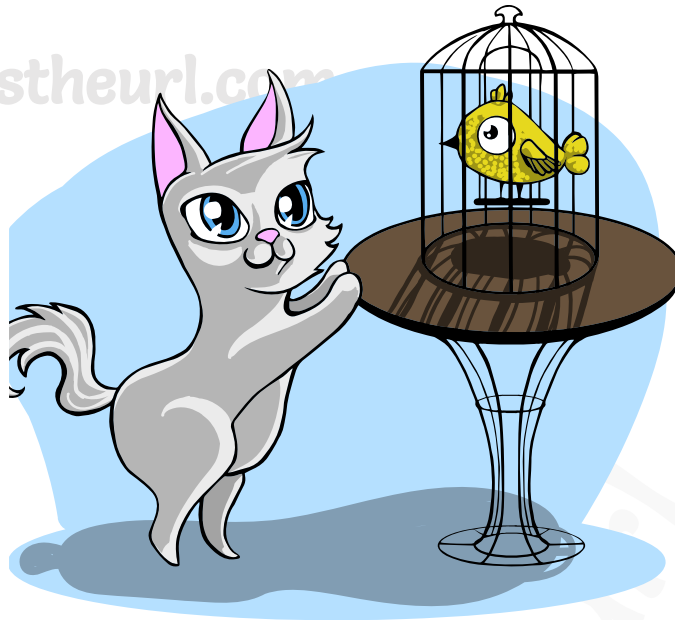

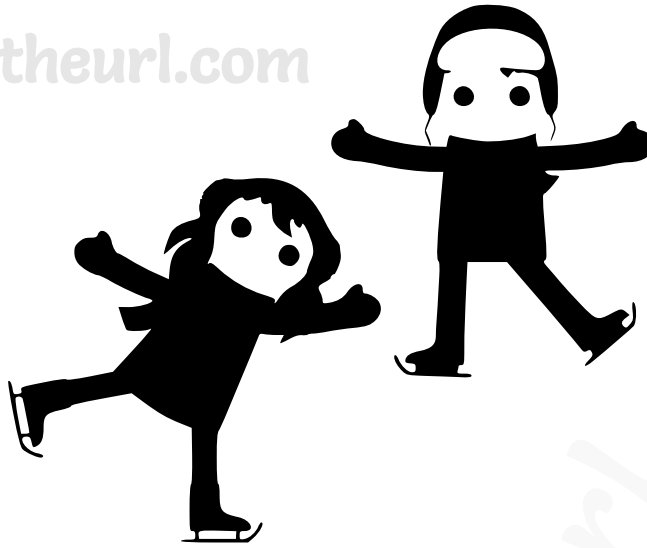
